





For example, I performed a couple of weeks ago right here in Michael J Fox Theatre for the Mid-autumn festival. Pipa is a four stringed Chinese traditional instrument that dates all the way back to the Han dynasty in 206 BC, and it is also known as the Chinese lute.

The piece I will be performing today is called "Language of Pipa"; the piece portrays a woman, in her last moments of life, writing a long moving letter to a famous writer, baring her desperate, loving affection. I hope you enjoy the song!






publisher locations / gymnasium marketplace map




Which of these four options would make the best new BCATML logo?


